

N4safe Report #18 ACTION UPDATE

Your help is urgently needed - contact the Mayor's office

As uncovered iby n4safe volunteers n January- Portland Mayor's office is taking over operation of the promised "TEMPORARY" NW Naito homeless facility - despite strong and continued opposition from the neighborhood and surrounding community.

IMPORTANT UPDATE:

N4safe volunteers have filed a LUBA (Land Use Board of Appeals) appeal - the city did not responded within the legal time line. The appeal at LUBA occured on APril 9, 2024 - and the referees have until May 6, 2024 to finalize and transit a decision. Further n4safe filed a legal action against the city for violations of the land use process.

The facility, which has been a constant commuity problem for the last 4 1/2 years, **was only allowed to operate for 5 years - according to the lease, approvals from State Department of Environmental Quality and approvals from the city itself.** Now the Mayor's office is takiing over operation without any proper legal and public process to review, solicit input and comply with the city's own land use process. *-continued below-*

Update: 4/16/24 DEQ decides to allow the city to continue operating the facility on contaminated land for another 5 years, despite writing in their decision:

"Decisions regarding site permitting and use reside outside of DEQ's regulatory authority"

"We agree that capping beyond 5 years begins to push the definition of "temporary".

Opposition to the coninuation of the NW Naito homeless facility (continued)

Legal and written commitments have been ignored as the city decided it would continue to operate the facility without Harbor of Hope, who bailed out of the facility in January. Tranisitons Projects, Inc continues operating the facility until June, it appears. The mayor's decision made with only one "public" session where the opposition was almost unanimous.

N4safe volunteers, Pearl District Neighborhood Association and hundreds of your friends and neighbors have rallied against the continuation of the facility.

Dozens of hours of testimony, letters, emails, calls and other communications to DEQ, Prosper Portland (owners of the property) and directly to the mayor and staff - all have been ignored. DEQ is the only public agency who has sought information, background and public involvment in a sincere and open manner.
